







Dear Principal,

Our office is currently recruiting new members for the 2022-2023 Mayor's Youth Advisory Commission (MYAC) session, and I would like to share some information with you about the program. My hope is that you will pass this along to anyone at your school who could help inform students who would be most interested in this opportunity.

WHAT IS MYAC?

MYAC is a group of selected high school students who live or attend a high school within the municipal boundaries of Glendale. The youth commission volunteers for community service activities, raises funds for projects, and provides the Mayor with information from a teen's perspective. Some of MYAC's annual community service projects include purchasing Christmas gifts for local children in need, collecting canned goods for local foodbanks, assisting with local charities, and more.

The activities of MYAC encourage Glendale youth to have pride in their community and develop the skills necessary for future leadership. MYAC members are asked to take part in all planned group events and share their perspectives with each other and the Mayor's office. Participating students are asked to share their ideas of how city government can be more responsive to youth issues and are encouraged to learn more about local government.

REQUIREMENTS

Each spring, the Glendale Mayor's Office begins accepting applications to become a MYAC member. To be eligible, a student must be of high school age (9th – 12th grade) during the upcoming school year and students must live within the municipal boundaries of Glendale or attend a high school within the municipal boundaries of Glendale. Membership is capped at 40 members who are appointed by the Mayor and our goal is to maintain diversity that is representative of each Glendale high school as well as home schooled and private school students. MYAC members in good standing are invited to serve throughout their entire high school career if they choose.

MYAC holds a mandatory orientation at the start of the new school year and monthly MYAC meetings are held on the last Thursday of the month 6:00PM-7:00PM at Glendale City Hall. Meetings run through the month of April with an end of school year dinner hosted by the Mayor in May.
